Advanced Study

Staff Scholarship

We call the Torah Etz Chaim—a Tree of Life—and, like a tree, in order to bear fruit it must have roots deep within the earth. In order to share Torah, our staff must be deeply rooted in their own dynamic Torah study. Our staff scholars maintain two intensive daily study sessions, each three hours in length, where in a group format they probe, study, and analyze the Torah.

This past year, our staff scholars completed one section of the laws of kashrus, in preparation for an advanced ordination in conjunction with Ner Israel Rabbinical College in Baltimore. An oral exam was administered by Rabbi Moshe Heinemann, who leads the Star-K Kashrus Agency.
